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## **ACRALYTE<sup>®</sup>**

### **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

Acralyte is a high end furniture finish. Proper care and maintenance will avoid problems and add years of outstanding service to the life of the product.

Acralyte offers an unmatched level of scratch resistance in the furniture industry. Nevertheless, dinnerware with abrasive undersides and other coarse items used in service can still cause the finish to scratch or become hazy. This type of damage is typically caused by dinnerware that was purchased with an unpolished or unsmoothed bottom. DO NOT use abrasive dinnerware or other coarse items in service.

Acralyte will withstand hot temperatures. However, dishes placed directly on the table at over 190°F can leave rings in the finish. DO NOT place items over 190°F directly on the table.

Acralyte is very chemical resistant. This finish is designed to withstand all household and industrial strength furniture cleaners. Please contact the factory or a factory representative if you are unsure as to how Acralyte will hold up to specific cleaners or chemicals.

These tables are designed and manufactured for indoor use only. DO NOT use these tables outdoors or in an area that is not climate controlled and protected from weather elements.

Care and maintenance instructions apply to high gloss, satin and matte - Acralyte® finishes.

**Daily Procedures:** Clean regularly with soap and water using a non-abrasive cloth rag or towel. If soap and water appear to streak, use Windex, 409 or any other glass cleaner to remove the streaks.

Table cleaning wipes designed to be used in restaurants can be used as an alternative to soap and water. These products will not affect the Acralyte finish.

**Periodic Procedures:** Periodically (every 2-4 weeks as needed), add ammonia or a strong degreasing solution (found at most hardware stores) to water to remove any grease buildup on the table. After all grease residue is removed, wash with soap and water then spray with glass cleaner to remove any streaks. This makes clean up after meals much easier, quicker, and cleaner. As grease builds up, it becomes harder to clean the tabletop.



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## **WARRANTY**

Products made by Table Topics are warranted to the original purchaser for a period of two years from the date of shipment to be free from factory defects in workmanship and materials. Claims related to defects of the product must be submitted prior to the expiration of the warranty period.

The warranty service will be provided without any charge when the product has been used for the purpose it was manufactured for and has been given reasonable care in transit, storage and operations. Such service will consist of repair at factory discretion or replacement of the defective product. In all cases, Table Topics does reserve the right of inspection prior to making a decision regarding warranty repair or replacement.

This warranty will not apply to products that are damaged by accident, improper use, abuse, misuse or neglect. This warranty does not apply if repairs are undertaken by anyone other than an authorized Table Topics representative. Table Topics does not assume labor charges associated with unauthorized repairs or unauthorized installation of warranty replacements.

This warranty does not apply to damage of the finish that is the result of items being placed directly on the table that are hotter than 190°F. Nor does it cover damage to the finish that is the result of abrasive dinnerware or tableware used in service. This includes dishes with abrasive bottoms.

These tables are designed and manufactured for indoor use only. Outdoor use or use in areas that are not climate controlled and protected from weather elements void all warranties.

Any claims regarding freight damage must be noted on the Bill of Lading at the time of delivery. Warranty claims regarding freight damage only apply to orders shipped by authorized Table Topics carriers. Freight claims regarding orders shipped by third party carriers must be made to the carrier itself.

Table Topics neither assumes, nor authorizes any person to assume for it, any other obligation of liability in connection with the sale of its products. This warranty is expressly in lieu of any other warranties, express or implied, including the warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.
